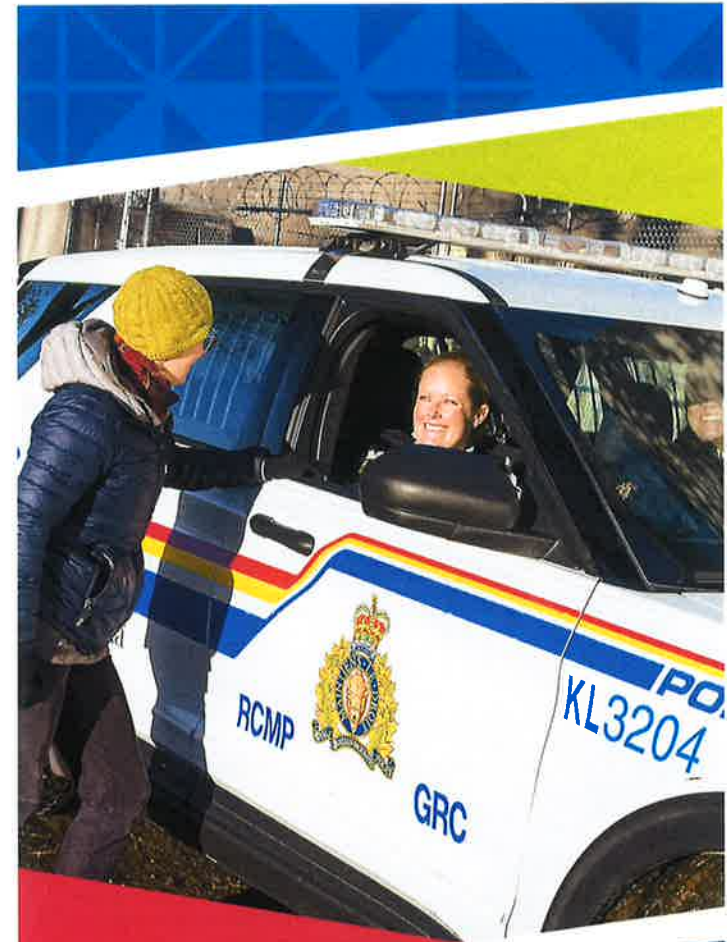

EMERGENCY

9-1-1



A serious crime has just occurred or is about to occur. This includes in-progress crime, or if someone's health, safety, or property is in jeopardy.



You have an emergency that requires immediate action from the police, ambulance, or fire.



RCMP NON-EMERGENCY

For non-emergency and general inquiries for:

- Reporting a crime after it has occurred
- Reporting stolen, lost or found property
- Reporting suspicious or illegal activity
- Obtaining general information from the RCMP
